Certification Reinstatement Policy

This policy takes affect in the event that a Tax Assessor/Collector or Deputy does NOT have requisite CE hours for TACA Professional Designation Certification Renewal in Calendar Year (membership year) ending Dec 31.

This reinstatement policy applies to the following TACA Certifications: PCAC, PDAC, PCC & CTOP.

The member may have their professional designation reinstated if the following steps are followed:

- 1. Between Jan 1 and March 31, they may earn the number of CE hours that were lacking on Dec 31.
- 2. Those hours will be credited toward the Dec 31 transcript.
- 3. Once the hours are verified, an administrative fee of \$25 will be billed.
- 4. Once the fee is received, the professional designation will be reinstated for the remainder of the calendar year.
- 5. Hours completed for reinstatement WILL NOT be credited towards the current year transcript.
