TAX ASSESSOR-COLLECTOR CONTINUING EDUCATION

SB 546 Purpose

COMPREHENSIVE

Provide a diverse and comprehensive continuing education program that better relates to the duties of the office.

FLEXIBILITY

Allow greater flexibility in meeting requirements by increasing online options and approved providers.

REGULATED

Create a continuing education structure that mirrors the regulation of other elected officials.



COMPARISON: PRE-SB 546 & CURRENT EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

PRF-SB 546

- 15 education hours per year 30 hrs per 2 years required
- Governing agency
 Texas Department of Licensing and Regulations
- Certifications
 Registered Tax Assessor Collector (RTA)
- Compliance procedure
 Possible TDLR fines

CURRENT EDUCATION REQUIREMENTS

20 education hours per year
Minimum
10 hours property tax collection education

Ethics and constitutional/statutory duties training

Governing agencies

Tax Assessor-Collectors Association of Texas

PLUS Hours Filed with Commissioner's Courts for local control and review

Certifications Minimum

Professional County Collector (PCC)
County Tax Office Professional (CTOP)

Advanced

Professional County Assessor-Collector (PCAC) & Professional Deputy Assessor-Collector (PDAC) requires both minimum certifications plus advanced courses
